What are we telling you about?

Our work to carry out "like for like" repairs to the Aldeburgh Town Marshes Wall.

Where is this work happening?

We will be undertaking these repair works at various sections of the embankment. Approximate repair locations marked on the maps overleaf.

When are we doing the work?

The work will start in middle of September 2022 and last for 8 to 10 weeks.

What will we be doing?

We'll be doing "like for like" repairs to the flood embankment to return it the condition it should be in. This includes repairs to the concrete revetments, scour protection, and any worn areas, on the front face.

Vehicular access to the riverbank for our operatives will be gained along the folding of the embankments and permission granted from the relevant landowners. Public footpaths will be temporarily diverted near the working areas during construction.

The repair works to the riverbank will help prevent further erosion and help protect people and their properties from tidal flooding.




